Parmesan Garlic Mashed Potatoes



Ingredients:

- 8 Lbs. Yukon gold potatoes (cubed & peeled)
- ³/₄ cups Sour cream
- 2 sticks Butter
- 2 cups Heavy whipped cream (warmed)
- 6 cloves Garlic minced
- ³/₄ cups Parmesan cheese
- 1 bunch Chives

Instructions:

- 1. Bring a large pot of water to a boil, with potatoes in it
- 2. Cook for about 20 30 minutes until fork goes right through
- 3. Drain the potatoes in a colander
- 4. Add the butter and garlic to the same pot you cooked the potatoes, cook on med heat for 3 4 minutes
- 5. Add the potatoes to the garlic and butter (use a ricer if you have one)
- 6. Add the warmed heavy whipped cream, parmesan cheese, sour cream and stir
- 7. Season with salt and pepper to taste
- 8. Garnish with chives

Ready for the snow?

1. Pack an emergency kit in your car equipped with: flashlight, one set of warm clothes (hat, gloves, socks, pants, jacket, etc.), pocket knife, road flares, first aid kit, non-perishable food like energy bars, lighter, water, batteries, ice scraper, tire chains, anything else you feel is necessary in case of an emergency

2. Restock your car with: windshield washer fluid, antifreeze fluid, fuel

3. Other helpful tips: check if your car needs new tires, winter tires or all-weather tires, put a GPS in your car in case the weather causes poor visibility, you won't miss a turn and if a road closes you will be able to find an alternative route
