

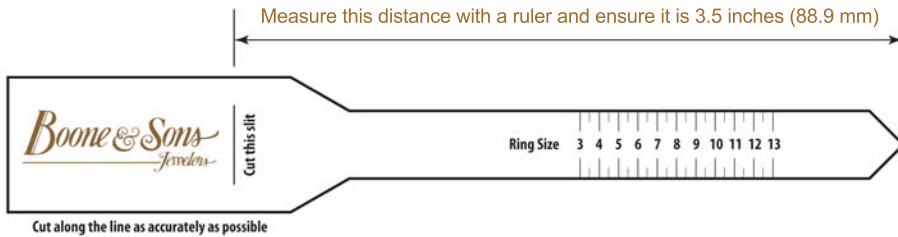
FIND YOUR RING SIZE

Please Note:

- Please ensure Page Sizing is set to “Actual size” or “none” under print options.
- Print this guide on standard 8 ½” x 11” letter size paper.

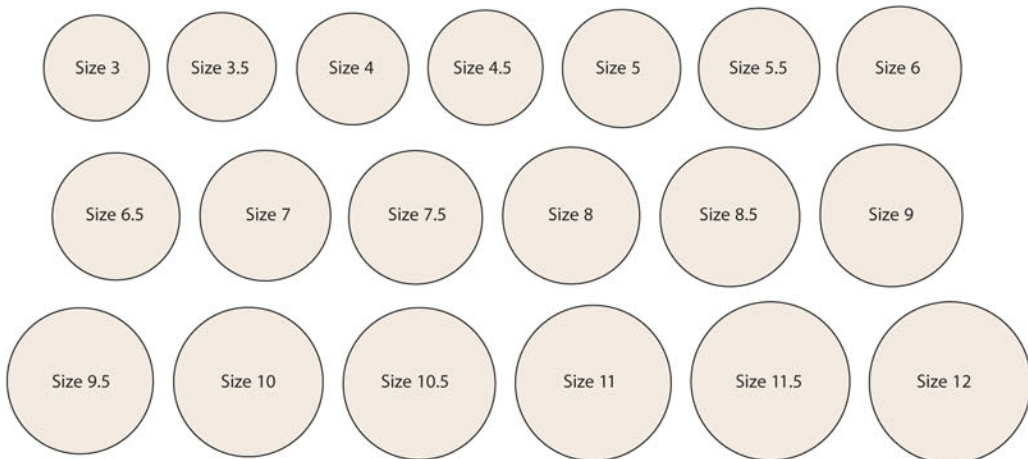
Option 1: Measure your finger with the ring sizer

1. Print this guide and ensure Page Sizing is set to “Actual size” or “none”.
2. With a ruler or tape measure, measure the distance between the slit and the pointed tip. Ensure that this measures 3.5 inches.
3. Cut along the outside of the ring sizer. Don't forget to cut the slit.
4. Wrap the ring sizer around your finger with the number side visible. Insert the pointed end into the slit and tighten.
5. Write down the number closest to the slit. The smaller ticks are half sizes. You now know your ring size.



Option 2: Measure an existing ring

1. Take your existing ring that fits the finger you intend to wear your new ring on.
2. Place the ring over the circles. The most closely matching size is a circle that is barely visible on the inside of the ring.
3. If you have a ring that falls between two sizes, choose the larger size when ordering a ring.
