## Quad Pole Installation Guide for Compression Mounting

(read entire guide before installing)
 Mount to ceiling With \#6 screws


## Proper Quad Pole Length:

Quad poles may range from 3" to 5" shorter than actual floor to ceiling height. (ie. 108" ceiling will have a 103 " to $105^{\prime \prime}$ actual length)

## Pole Installation:

1. Tighten the Top Leveler ( 2 screw holes for ceiling mount) into the top of the pole.
Tighten the Bottom leveler into the bottom.
2. Position bottom of pole into desired location and turn top leveler clockwise so that the top of the pole is from 1 " to 2 " from the ceiling.
3. Use the wrench to extend the bottom leveler until the pole is compressed from floor to ceiling. Do not over tighten or extend leveler beyond 2".
4. If poles are mounted with a rear supporting wall, the top leveler does not need to be screwed into the ceiling.
5. Check and adjust pole location using a level to make sure they are plumb and secure. Mount to ceiling if necessary.

## Installing Brackets and Cabinets:

All ISS Brackets need to be inserted into the pole from the bottom of the pole into the back or front channel in the proper order for top to bottom. Make sure there is room at the bottom to insert brackets or add before installing poles. Fusion Brackets and Shelf End Supports may be installed after poles are in place. Threaded sides of the poles are for cabinet mounting.
