

# THE ORIGINAL ROCKFORD RED HEEL MONKEY

PATTERN

### Step 1

SOCKONE

From sock one, turn sock inside out. Start 3" from white heel and sew two seams 1/2" apart and across end of the cuff.



Step 4

Sew up opening from top to bottom so that legs are spread apart and not pulled together.



Step 2

Cut sock between the two seams to within 1-1/2" of white heel. This leaves opening for turning and stuffing.



Step 5

To shape head, tie loosely at neck with thread. For a more defined head, tie thread tighter.



Step 3

Turn sock right side out. Stuff and mold to desired shape.



Step 6

For feet, bend legs into L-shape for desired foot length and sew crease with strong white thread.





Step 7

Using the second sock, turn the sock inside out and draw the pattern onto the sock using your fabric marker. See Figure 1 for pattern.

Step 8

For tail, seam inside trim line. Seam ears along trim line.



**Step 12** 

For ears, the extra material around the trim line that's folded inside creates shape. If desired, add stuffing before stitching to head.



#### Step 9

Cut pieces of pattern out on traced lines. For ears trim to 1/4" outside lines. Cut ears open at fold.



Step 13

For mouth, fold brown along white edge of heel inside before stitching. Whip stitch bottom edge first, stuff and stitch around top.

Turn and stuff tail and arms.

Stitch on arms at shoulders

at an angle to make arms

hang down instead of out.

on monkey's bottom.

Attach tail just above white



Step 14

For eyes, place felt circles above mouth as desired and whip stitch with black thread.



#### That's it!

You're monkey's now complete! You can further personalize your monkey on your own.
