FASHION STYLING With the Color Wheel



The Color Wheel is used in basic color theory by stylists, designers and artists to create color schemes.

COMPLIMENTARY

Colors on opposite sides of the wheel are Complementary.

(Ex: blue and orange, or purple and yellow)

HARMONIZING

Colors neighboring on the wheel are called Harmonizing Colors.

(Ex: red, burgundy and maroon)

Monochromatic

A unified, one-color scheme - using that color's various tints, tones and shades - is called Monochromatic.



Follow the connecting lines on the color wheel to match complimentary colors.
