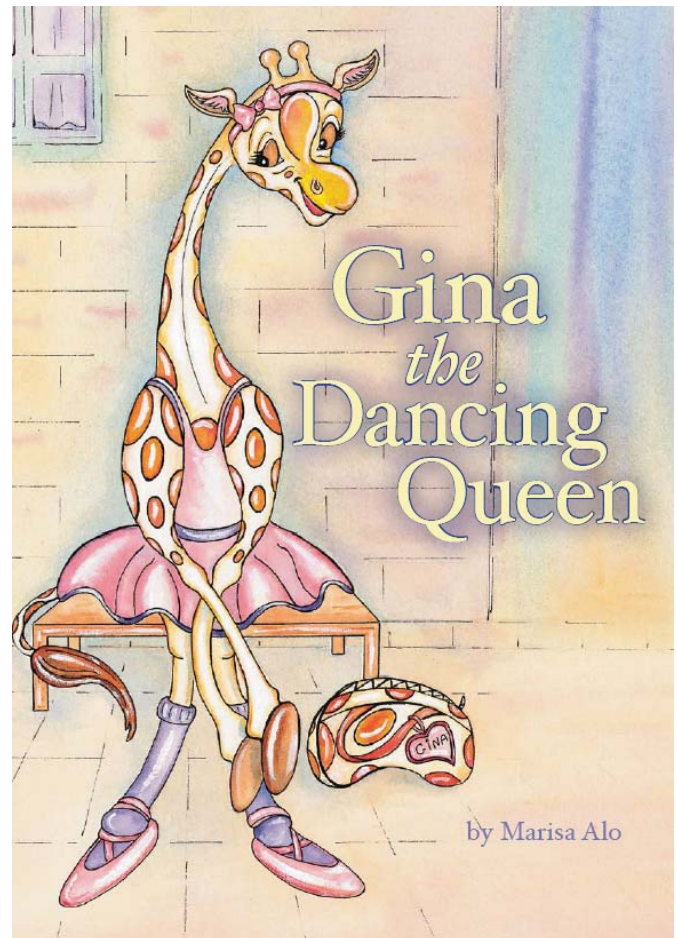
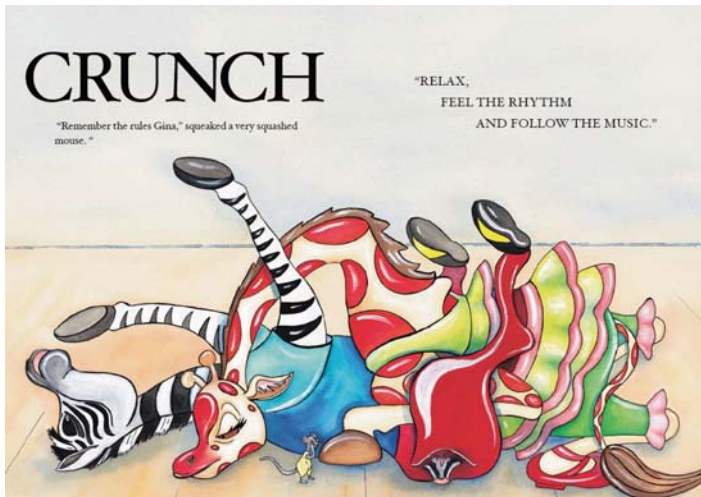


Gina the Dancing Queen
