

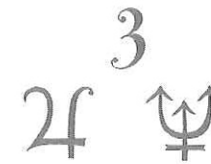

## NUMBERS AND PLANETS

Those born on the 3<sup>rd</sup> of the month are ruled by the number 3 and by the planet Jupiter. Though those ruled by the number 3 tend to rise to the highest positions in their particular sphere, March 3 people are influenced by Neptune (ruler of Pisces) and can thus be indecisive and overly passive at critical times.
