The Bible is God's storybook. It tells us about God's loving relationship with humankind. It is made up of lots of books written thousands of years ago.



The Bible is in two parts.

The Old Testament is the story of God and his chosen people, the Jews, often called the children of Israel.



Jesus healed people. Jesus taught us how to love God and each other. Jesus died on a cross and rose again.



This happened over 2000 years ago, but we can still hear God speaking to us through the people who wrote the Bible when we listen to it being read or read it ourselves.

We can do this in lots of ways.

In church, when we listen to God's word being read from the Bible, we know that he is close to us.





When the reading is about the things that Jesus said and did, it is called the Gospel.

'Gospel' means 'good news'.

We listen to what Jesus said and then we try to do what he tells us.
