

HEY THERE

Congratulations on your purchase of the GRAIN AUDIO PBS.01, you're going to love these things.

There are a few things you should know about the PBS. First, your PBS is a passive speaker system. This means you'll be hooking your pair up to the powered amplifier of your choice. Two, these speakers are a matched pair, meaning there is a designated left and right speaker. Please take a look at the back of each speaker to determine which is which. Finally, the grill isolation panels on the PBS are made of solid wood, please don't get these wet. Also, use a coaster if you have to place your favorite beverage on them... though we highly encourage you away from this type of behavior. The placement, not the beverage.

Besides that, please take a look through this manual for the basics on installation and setup.

POWER

Your GRAIN AUDIO PBS.01 has been designed to be powered by the amplifier or receiver of your choice. Keep in mind the following power requirements when integrating these speakers into and existing system or when purchasing new components.

POWER: 25-75 WATTS MAX IMPEDANCE: 8 OHMS

Note: Please don't over power these speakers, there's really no reason to. Plus, if they get blown out you'll have a pair of speakers that can't play music, and that's no fun for anybody.



PLACEMENT

Placement of your speakers is key to the listening experience. These diagrams are not hard and fast rules but they give you a direction for placement of your speakers within your listening area.

Basically you're looking for an equidistant relationship between the speakers and your listening position (figA).

Center the PBS.01 vertically level with your ears in your most frequent listening position (figB).

Note: As stated earlier this is a matched pair of speakers. Please refer to the serial number plaque on the back of each speaker for individual channel designation.

CONNECTION

Your PBS.01 must be connected in phase. This means the positive terminal on your speaker must be connected to the positive terminal on your amplifier. The negative terminals follow suit. Follow the diagram below when setting up a new system or integrating the PBS into your existing configuration.



Notes: 1. Turn off your amplifier before making any connections.

- 2. As stated earlier this is a matched pair of speakers. Please refer to the serial number plaque on the back of each speaker for individual designation.
- 3. Use 16 gauge (AWG), copper wire minimum and larger gauge wire for longer runs. The connection terminals on your loudspeaker will accommodate bare wire, or banana type plugs.
- 4. Ensure that the positive and negative speaker wires don't touch. This will damage your amplifier.



CARE AND FEEDING

This product contains real, solid wood. Wood is a great material for making audio products and it is also a beautiful material, the natural color and grain variations inherent to the wood are part of this beauty.

Being made from a natural material there are a few precautions to take when using your Grain Audio product...

1-Keep things dry. Wood (and electronics by the way) don't like being wet or submerged in liquid... steam saunas aren't great places for them either. Please keep this in mind.

2-Take care. The wood housing of your Grain Audio product will take some bumps and bruises. Unlike harder plastics these scrapes may show but that's okay; these will not affect the sound quality of your product. Plus, it'll make you look cool.

3-Shade. Wood will change color over time. This is a result of the natural interaction between the wood, oxygen and sunlight. We're pretty sure you can't control the oxygen content in the air around your Grain Audio product but you can keep it out of prolonged exposure to direct sunlight. No sunscreen though, that would be bad.

4-Finish. The wood in your Grain Audio product is protected by a durable water resistant finish. It is designed to last the life of the product and should not need refinishing. However, an occasional cleaning with a soft cloth will help keep things pretty.

TROUBLESHOOTING

No music?

- Check that your amplifier is powered up.
- If applicable, check to make sure that you have the PBS.01 selected at your amplifier.
- Check that the volume at your amplifier.
- Check that your speaker cables are attached firmly to the mounting posts on the back of the speakers and the terminals on the back of your amp.

Doesn't sound quite right?

 Make sure you haven't wired your speakers out of phase. Meaning that your speaker and amplifier terminals are connected in the right order. Go back to the "CONNECTION" section for further explanation.
