Dos Lagos Vineyards 2008 Cabernet Sauvignon Retail - \$125

New vineyard, new winery – Robert Foley is the winemaker!

1,650 feet in the hills of Atlas Peak, this rocky terroir is actually volcanic rock called “Tuff.” Translation of Dos Lagos is “Two Lakes.” The vineyard is 4 acres that slope down to the lakes.

Amazing wine . . . we love this for it’s ultra rich and ripe style. Dark berry, cherry, cassis, chocolate . . . need I go on?

At one of our Premiere Wine Tastings, our group was so impressed with this wine that I knew I had to acquire some for you. This wine is totally sold-out on the wholesale side, glad we were able to get it for you.

Buoncristiani 2010 Napa Valley Chardonnay Retail - \$45.00

This is a new one for us. The Buoncristiani brothers have come out of the box with some incredible wines. This chardonnay has just the perfect balance between a Rombauer & Kistler Chardonnay. Minerality, great acidity and richness.

315 cases of this wine were made. Barrel fermented a la Rombauer, Sur Lie aged (think Kistler) and then only 28% malolactic fermentation. New oak, 2 year old oak and stainless were used.

Harmony and balance are what I get out of this outstanding example of Napa chardonnay. We don’t put too many whites in your Club 70 shipments, but this one deserves to be there for sure. Enjoy!
