

Forest Queen Hat









FINISHED SIZE

20" circumference at rib, 31" circumference at largest part of beret.

YARN

O -WOOL CLASSIC WORSTED (100% certified organic merino, 99 yds/ 90m [50g/ 1.75 oz]); 2 skeins, shown in 4412 Dogwood.

GAUGE

4 sts and 5 rows = 1" in Stockinette Stitch. 1 repeat of Leaf Chart = 2.75" wide by 5.75" tall. Take time to save time, check your gauge.

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NEEDLES

Size 7 (4.5 mm): 16" circular (cir) and double-pointed (dpn). Adjust needle size if necessary to obtain the correct gauge.

NOTIONS

Stitch markers, tapestry needle.

HAT

CO 66 sts on 16" circ ndl and join in the round. Place marker to indicate beginning of rnd.

Work Rows 1-33 of Leaf Chart, repeating the chart 11 times width wise.

Change to dpns as neccessary.

Row 34: *P11, pm, rep from * 5 more times.

Row 35-43: *p to 2 sts before m, p2tog, slm, rep from * 5 more times.

Row 44: *p2tog, slm, rep from * 5 more times.

FINISHING

Cut yarn. With tapestry needle, thread through remaining 6 sts and cinch closed. Weave in all ends. Hand wash in cold water and gentle detergent. Wet block over 10" diameter plate.
