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We have created this guide to help you, but ring sizing is hard to determine accurately from a paper printout. To be absolutely sure of your size you should be measured by your local jeweler or at one of our NYC stores.

Keep in mind that many of our rings (including those from our 1909 collection, engraved wedding bands, and re-sized antique rings) are FINAL SALE, so purchase carefully! We cannot be responsible for conversion errors, paper sizer malfunctions, typos, or any other ring sizing mistakes made on your end.

HOW TO USE THIS RING SIZING GUIDE:

Before you print this page, set the page orientation (file>page setup) to "horizontal". Make sure to uncheck all "scale to print" checkboxes, and ensure that "page scaling" is set to "none" on your print dialog box.

Use a ring that fits you just the way you like on the finger you intend to wear the ring. Place it over the circles below to find your size.

Match the INSIDE diameter of the ring to the circle's outline.

In the United States, engagement and wedding rings are traditionally worn on the "ring finger" (the finger between your pinky and middle finger) on the left hand.


TIPS FOR MEASURING YOUR RING SIZE:

Try not to use a ring with a stone or large decorative feature. The irregular shape will cause distortion and you're likely to get an inaccurate reading. For best results, use a plain, thin band.

Remember, each one of your fingers is a different size, so a ring you wear on your right hand will not fit your matching finger on the left.

Never use a string to measure your ring size - they stretch, which may give you an erroneous reading.

If you're buying a wide band, they tend to feel tighter than thin bands, so err on the large size when ordering. If your knuckles are extra-big, order the size between the measurement of your knuckle and the measurement of the base of your finger.



Measurements match the inside edge of the ring.



The line printed here should measure EXACTLY one inch.
