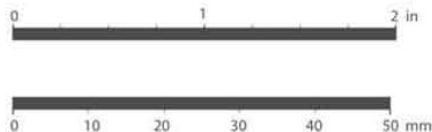


## 2 Ways To Determine Your Ring Size

Please Carefully Read the Following Printing Instructions:

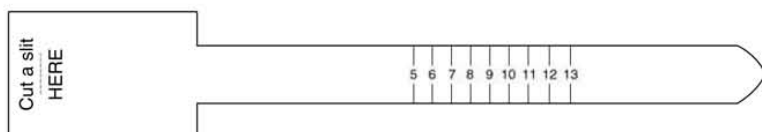
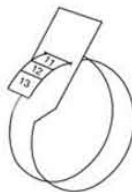
### Confirm Paper Size



1. Prior to printing, confirm that page scaling is set to 100% in the print dialog.
2. With a ruler, measure the bars on the left to ensure that you have printed this page at an accurate size
3. If sizing is incorrect, please confirm that you are printing the page at 100% and try again

### 1. To Use Our Ring Sizer, Follow These Steps:

1. **Print it** -- make sure to uncheck the "fit to page" and "shrink oversized pages to paper size" options in your print window.
2. Cut out the sizer.
3. Make a slot in the sizer by cutting along the dotted line.
4. Roll the sizer into a circle with the numbers on the outside.
5. Insert the end of the tab into the slot.
6. Place the sizer around your finger and pull the tab through the slot until the paper is snug around your finger.
7. Read your finger size on the scale.

### 2. To Use a Ring You Already Own To Find Your Ring Size:

Place a ring you already own over the circles below. Your correct ring size will be the largest circle with lines still visible from the inside of the ring. Note the number that corresponds to the circle — this is your ring size. All ladies' rings are available in whole sizes 5 through 11. No half sizes. Limited availability of some rings in size 12. Men's rings available in sizes 9 through 13.
