What you'll need

A brown paper grocery bag

If there's printing on the bag, just cut a panel from another paper bag and glue it on for a plain surface.

Construction paper

9" x 12" sheets:

Blue (2 Sheets), Black (1 Sheet), White (1 Sheet)

Scissors

Pencil

Ruler

Glue stick

Snack

(Optional)

Here wee go!

Step 1

Cut out templates, and use as guides to cut all shapes from construction paper as directed.

Step 2

Prepare the paper bag

(carefully remove handles, cut eye slot, cut arm holes).

Step 3

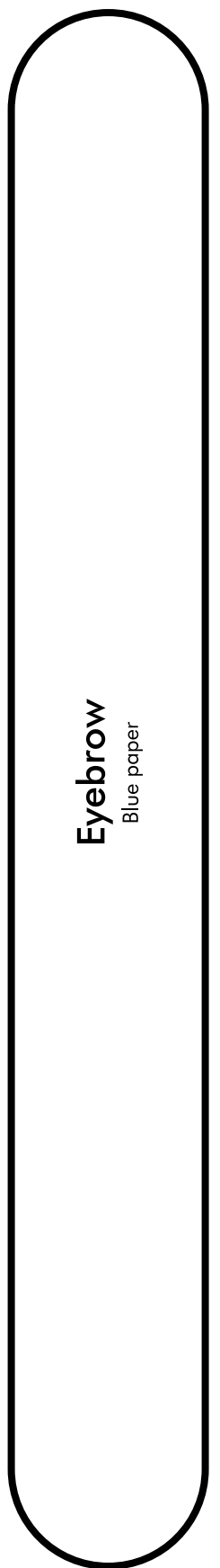
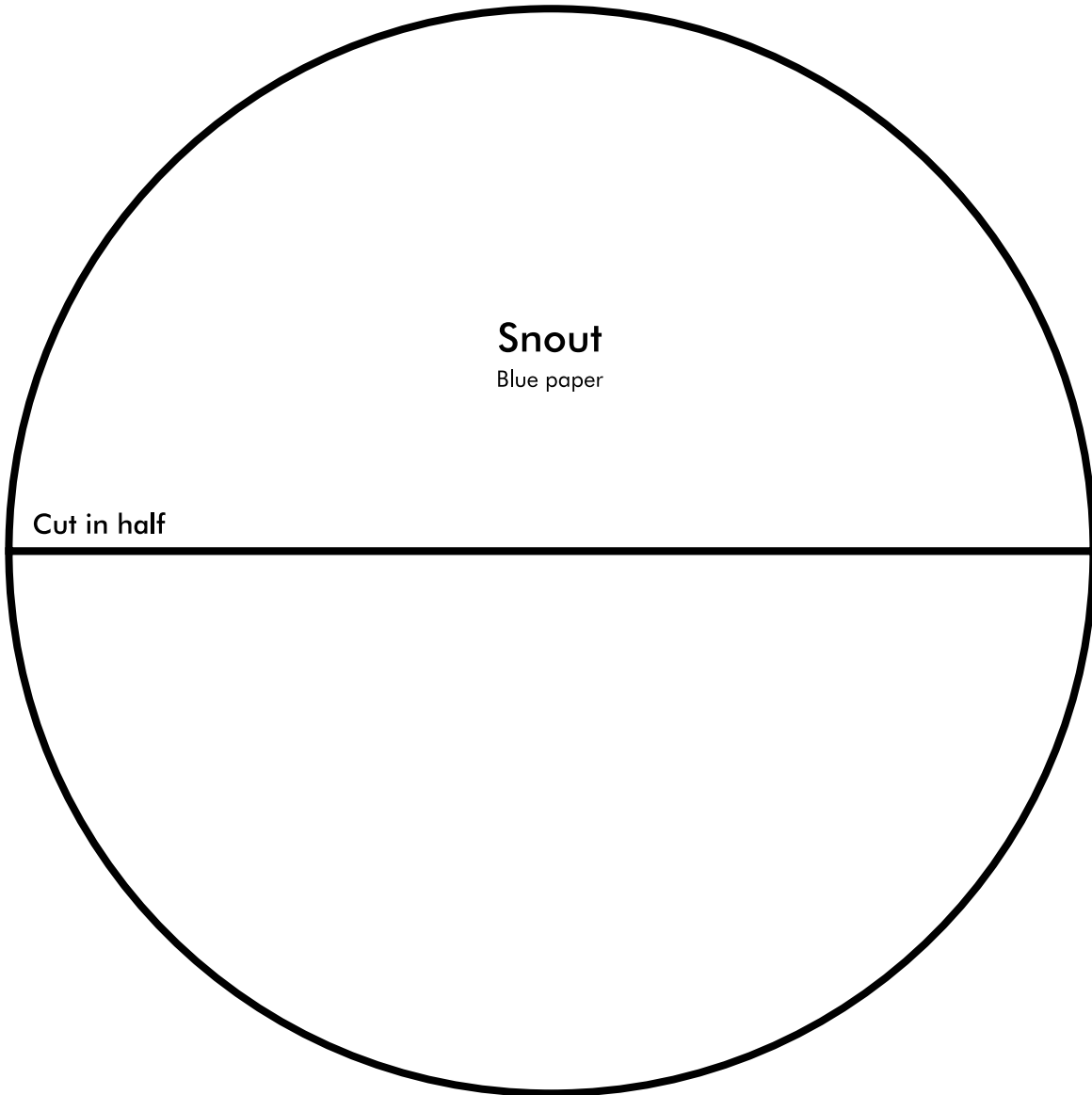
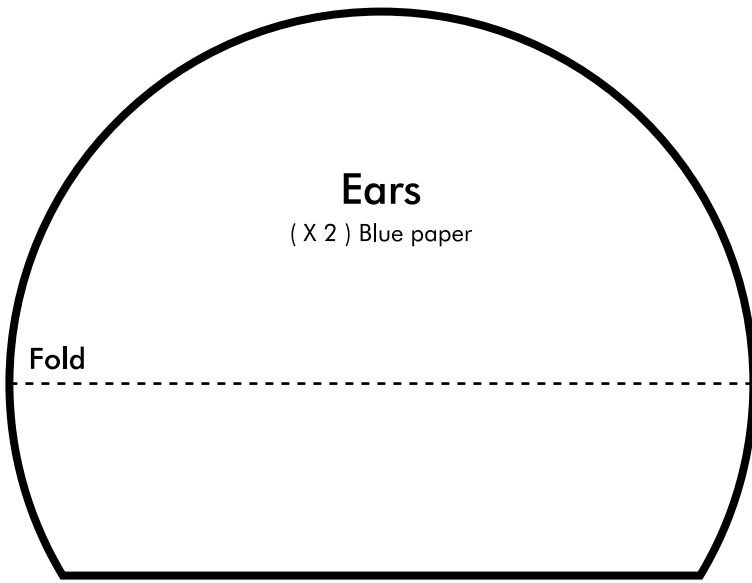
Glue all pieces together & onto the bag.

Peekaboo eye slot

3 1/2" from top edge / centered left to right

Be sure there's plenty of space in the eye holes for your little one to see. And if your kiddo doesn't like head-covering, no problem -- just cut a hole in the top of the bag so the head can poke through. (The Wee Alpha will be on the kid's chest.)

Arm holes

(X 2) Approximately 9 1/2" from top of bag
centered left to right

You may need to experiment
with size and location
of arm holes depending on the
height of your little one.

Pupils

(X 2)
Black paper

Nostrils

(X 2) Black
paper

Inner ears

(X 2) Black paper

Eyes

(X 2) White paper

Bottom edge

(X 2) Blue paper

(1) Black paper

(1) White paper
