Join us in the thrilling hunt for rare coins! Though most pocket change is worth only face value, there are several die varieties and year-mintmark combinations that are worth more—sometimes a lot more. Here are some of the most desirable rare U.S. coins from the late 19<sup>th</sup> century to today. Most of these are valuable even in poor condition, while many other coins (not listed) become valuable only in better condition. Gold and silver coins are always worth at least their metal value, and key dates are usually more valuable than that. Coins from the 19<sup>th</sup> century and earlier—including the half cent, 2-cent piece, 3-cent piece, and 20-cent piece—are always treasured finds, with rare varieties too many to list here.
