ELECTRONIC JOURNAL module

The Electronic Journal is a powerful tool that allows you to search for transactions or activity based on a wide range of criteria.

The review functions allow you to scroll through any day's sales journal at the touch of a few buttons.

System features include:

- EJ review accessible directly from POS for reprint and cancel of past transactions.
- Filtered search available in electronic journal.
- Files accumulated in secure format that provides easy backup routine.
- Journals are merged on L-BOSS server on the fly as transactions are completed on the registers.
- Each L-POS terminal creates a redundant copy of the EJ file after each sale on its own hard drive.

Data search with drill-down filters

The search feature includes an operator-oriented statement builder that allows you to locate the data you need to find with minimum effort. For example, you can search for a transaction by amount, by function, by cashier, store, date, terminal, quantity, account or any combination of the above. The system also includes pre-defined search statements that will display all corrections, refunds, or suspicious transactions like training, pickups, cancelled transactions, etc.

Memorizing search statements

The Electronic journal system allows you to record search statements that you need to use repeatedly to speed things up and reduce errors. The statements you record can have as many as 8 arguments.

Custom reports

The Electronic journal system can be further enhanced with personalized reports that can be used when specific data recorded in a sale may not be part of the normal report database. For example, if you add a prompt to ask for a driver license number when a cheque is accepted the driver license number is recorded in the journal.

EJ printing

Data recorded in the electronic journal can be printed to either the default system printer or to the receipt printer on an L-POS terminal. It is possible to re-print a transaction, a series of transactions or even an entire day. If you have used the data filter to search for specific data, the EJ system can also print the search results to your system printer.

Windows XP or Windows 2000.
PC PIII 700 or greater with 256 meg ram and 30 gig hard drive.
L-BOSS and L-POS are required to use this optional module.
