## **INSTRUCTIONS**

**NO TOOLS NEEDED -** You will only need a pair of scissors to cut the strapping on the box. No other tools are needed. The Equicizer is completely assembled; all you have to do is attach the neck straps and the wheels by hand.

## \*NOTE\*

Once you receive your Equicizer, it will be easier for you to handle, lift and maneuver once removed from the box and all its packaging. The Equicizer weights approximately 160 pounds out of the package. You should have at least 2 people when using stairs etc.

## **STEP BY STEP INSTRUCTIONS:**

1.) Cut the strapping outside the box. The box can be completely dismantled starting from the lid on the top.



2.) Once most of the box (lid and walls) have been removed, the Equicizer is sitting in a wooden tray. Cut all remaining strapping you see and the Equicizer can be lifted from the remaining tray. WHEN HANDLING WOODEN TRAY USED FOR PACKAGING, BE CAREFUL AND WATCH OUT FOR WOOD SPLINTERS!

3.) Once removed, the Equicizer will be easier to handle. Now that all strapping has been removed including the strapping that secures the neck, the Equicizer has to be carefully set up on its rear end. Inside at the base of the neck, you will see the resistant straps already in place.

4.) Attach the resistant straps. All you need to do is use your hand to reach inside the Equicizer and attach the resistant straps (bands) that are already in place, to the "T" bracket that you will see. Weight Straps are warranted for 1 year. The replacement time depends on the amount of usage. It varies from 5-10 years under normal usage.



There are 2 retainer clips in place already securing the bands to the bracket. No other retainer clips are needed.



5.) Attach wheels. While the Equicizer is sitting up on its rear end, now is a good time to attach the wheels. Make sure the wheels are in the locked position. See the 4 threaded mounts on the Equicizers steel frame. Insert the stem of the wheel into the steel mount on the frame and turn the entire wheel clockwise to tighten it, using your hands. Make sure you have them tight to work properly. Wheels are warranted for 1 year. Replacement time depends on normal usage. **They will need to be checked periodically to insure they stay tight and secure.**
