
8a SET RANGE-OF-MOTION (ROM)


Depress Extension Button and slide to desired ROM setting. Depress Flexion Button and slide to desired ROM setting. NOTE: ROM settings automatically lock into place.




The Lock Hinge allows the brace to be locked at a specific setting. The hinge can be locked in 10° increments ranging from -10 to 100.

Bend the arm to desired setting and engage lock. This will lock the brace in place independent of ROM settings. Make sure ROM settings do not interfere with desired lock setting.



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WEE BOW ELBOW BRACE

1 UNLOCK THE HINGE

The WeeBow Elbow Brace is packaged in the locked position. Slide the Lock button away from the hinge to unlock the brace.

2 RELEASE ALL FOUR STRAPS

Pull each strap through the D-ring and attach it back on itself to prevent entanglement.

3 POSITION THE BRACE

Position the hinge over the lateral humeral epicondyle (outer elbow).

4 SET THE ARM LENGTH

While the hinge is aligned with the elbow (see Step 3), make length adjustments to the forearm.

- 43 Slide the locking clip over to expose the length adjustment button.
- 4b Depress the length adjustment button and extend the plate to the desired length (forearm).
- Secure the locking clip by sliding it over the length adjustment button to lock the button in place.
- Repeat the same process to adjust the humeral arm length.

APPLY THE BRACE

Position the brace, be sure that the hinge is centered over the elbow joint. Form the black aluminum plates around the forearm and upper arm.

6 SECURE THE STRAPS

Beginning with the strap just below the hinge (1), fasten each strap by sliding it through the D-ring and pulling the strap back upon itself to the desired tension and attaching it to the double-sided hook. Fasten the strap closest to the hand next (2), then the strap just above the hinge (3), and last the strap at
