



Field Reports June 2012



Hello Steve,
I've been using my new Longliners from Angler Innovations. First evening—two Lake Trout and one Coho salmon. Next day—two person limit of 3 Lake Trout each (photo attached). The largest so far has been 6 pounds.

More action trolling with your Longliner than with other boats when fishing from my Southwind KAYAK.

The guys are me (Terry Switzer) on the left and my friend (Hoikki Poikennen in the red). Fish were caught behind Longliner trolling a floating jerkbait behind a 10" flasher about 30 feet behind Longliner close to the bottom in about 25 feet of water, near the mouth of the Michipicoten River in Ontario, Canada.

Will soon be going out for rainbows and salmon which will be feeding deep on baithfish (mostly smelt) here and I figure I'll need at least 4 ounces of weight to get down 50 or 60 feet.
