Trace each outline onto a sheet of acetate; cut it out with an X-Acto knife. Spray the back with low-tack spray mount; place it on the paper, sticky side down. Thinly and evenly coat with matte-black spray paint. Let dry, then carefully peel off the acetate. Use black frames with white mats to make your prints pop.
