

READ FIRST BEFORE CONSTRUCTING ANY 37MM ROUND

1. Check federal, state, and local laws before constructing any 37mm round. Laws do vary from state to state and city to city.
2. Buyer assumes all risk involved in loading, reloading, constructing, and using 37mm cartridges.
3. Buyer acknowledges and understands that loading, reloading, constructing, and using 37mm rounds can be extremely dangerous.
4. Constructing, possessing, and / or using anti-personnel rounds with an unregistered launcher is prohibited by Federal Law. Before you construct, possess, and / or use any anti-personnel rounds you must first register your launcher as a destructive device with the BATF&E, pay the appropriate tax and wait for your approval.
5. The buyer understands that if you are found guilty of owning an unregistered destructive device it is likely that you will be sentenced to a mandatory prison sentence. **Ignorance of the law is not a defense or excuse.**
6. Verify with the manufacturer of your launcher to determine what is safe for your launcher. Some rounds are not safe to fire from all devices and all launchers are not equal in design and strength.
7. With an un-registered launcher, **NEVER** use more than .25oz of explosive material. This includes your lifting charge and payload. .25oz is roughly equivalent to 109 grains do not exceed this.
8. Flash powder is not to be used in a 37mm launcher it will most likely cause your launcher to blow up and maim, injure, and even kill you.
9. Know your surroundings, target, and what lies beyond. 37mm rounds present a risk of starting a fire and it is recommended that you have a fire extinguisher on hand when firing.
10. The information provided in this packet is for informational purposes. If you choose to use this information to construct a round YOU DO SO AT YOUR OWN RISK.
11. Exotic firearms does not claim to be experts in any matter pertaining to 37mm loading, including the rules and regulations. DO YOUR OWN RESEARCH. There are many more safety guidelines besides these you should follow this is the short list. Do your own research before constructing 37mm rounds. Double check your local laws and regulations. If you don't know or understand something ask someone who does know.
