Below is a list of items recommended to help you in the process of reloading your 37mm casings

-HOT GLUE GUN (A LARGE ONE)

with lots of glue sticks

-A UTILITY KNIFE (SHARP NEW BLADE)

needed to cut fused projectiles fuses down to 1/4"

-PAPER TOWELS

I always lay them down on top of my work surface to make clean up easy plus you occasionally may need a piece to help make a

-BLACK POWDER MEASURING TOOL

Its easy and it works KNOW WHAT YOU ARE PUTTING IN YOUR ROUNDS!!!



-FUNNEL

Use it with your black powder measuring tool to load casings and fill the measuring tool

-LATEX GLOVES

Keeps the hands clean and the TSA from strip searching you when fly the next day

-NAIL PUNCH

I use this to push the primers out of expended casings before I clean them

-BABY BOTTLE BRUSH

Used to clean your casings and your launcher makes a quick job of it.



$\underline{\text{-}12"}$ BAR CLAMP (the kind you squeeze tight with one hand)

It helps to insert primers into plastic casings

-EYE PRO

Just to be safe

There are more things needed for reloading some more specialized rounds but this will get you started
