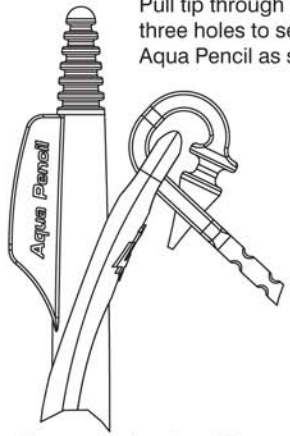
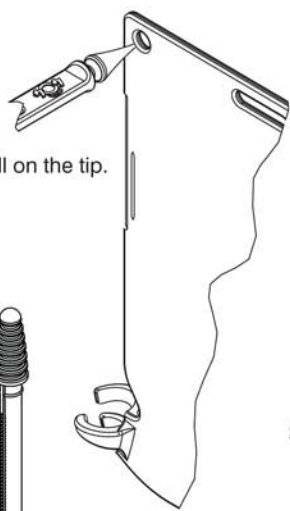




## Steps to attach tether to Aqua Pencil and Slate

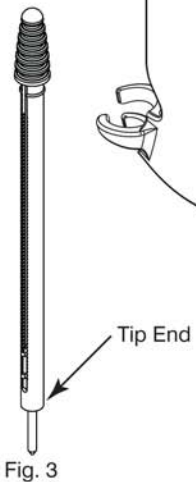
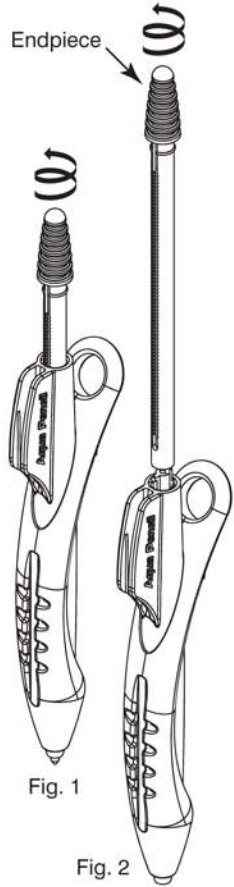
Put through hole on Aqua Pencil.  
Pull tip through one of the three holes to secure tether to Aqua Pencil as shown.

Pull tip through hole as shown.  
\*hint: Use your shirt/cloth to pull on the tip.  
You will need to pull hard.



## Steps for replacing lead in your Aqua Pencil:

① When the pencil gets to the end of its travel, the Endpiece will not turn any more. Pull the remaining lead out of the pencil. Once you have removed the remaining lead, gently press in a new stick - it will push in just slightly. Then spin the Endpiece counter clockwise to pull the new lead into the pencil.



## Steps if the lead is too short and you can not pull it out:

② Spin the Endpiece 2-3 turns counter clockwise then pull the Endpiece until it pops out of the pencil a short ways. See Fig. 1. Continue to spin the Endpiece counter clockwise until it comes out of the pencil. See Fig. 2. Find the Runner in the Endpiece and slide it all the way to the tip end. Pull out the exposed lead. See Fig. 3.

## Steps if the lead is broken inside the Runner:

③ Spread the Endpiece so the Runner falls out. See Fig. 4. Use a small paperclip and push the broken lead out of the Runner. See Fig. 5. Push the Runner back into the Endpiece, oriented correctly. Insert the Endpiece back into the tube and turn clockwise 2-3 turns. Next, push the Endpiece into the tube until it snaps into place. Once you have removed the remaining lead, gently press in a new stick - It will push in just slightly. Then spin the Endpiece to pull the new lead into the pencil.

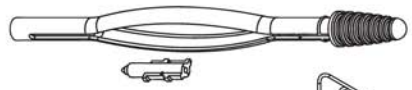

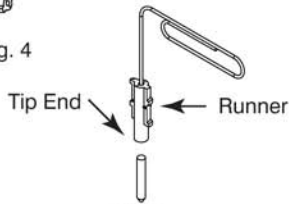
