

The Dorchester

The Dorchester is a hand-made pendant light fitting, in hand-blown lampworked glass made in the UK.

The curvaceous form of the pendant evokes the idea of the hourglass profile of the 50's pin-up, and the ribbed finish of corsetry and detail of lace.

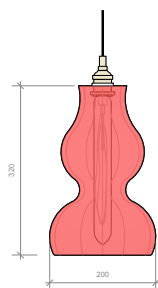
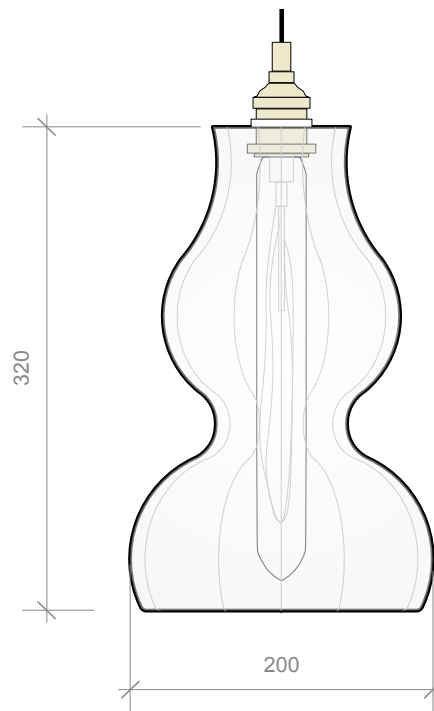
The subtle intricacy of the of the glass creates subtle reflections around the room.

This product is hand-made lampworked borosilicate glass.

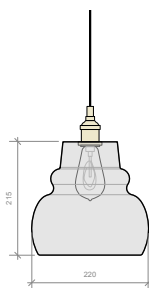

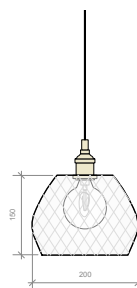

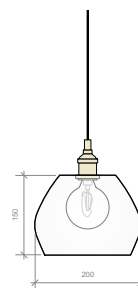

Installation & Cleaning



Please read all instructions before installing your light. Before starting any electrical work always switch off at the mains. If in any doubt, please always consult a qualified electrician.

Installation

1. Before commencing any work ensure that the electricity supply is off.
2. Before unpacking it is advisable to wear cotton gloves as the glass is clean and this would avoid you having to clean off fingerprints after installation.
3. Remove cable ties on the flex and remove all packaging.
4. Cut flex back to desired height. Strip the wires and pass flex through the grip on the ceiling rose.
5. Thread the flex through both lower holes on the plastic clip so it creates an 's' bend.
6. Whilst supporting light and shade, wire in junction box observing polarity.

The wires in the mains lead are coloured with the following code:
Brown = Live, Blue = Neutral, Green/Yellow = Earth (if applicable)

You may need to connect together the looping in wires, if in any doubt consult a qualified electrician

7. Now fix the ceiling rose to the ceiling ensuring that the screws are going into suitable load bearing material (i.e. wooden beam or suitable Rawl plugs).

8. Whilst still supporting the light, firmly tighten the cord grip on the ceiling rose until it is taking the weight of the light.

9. Before switching on check that the fixings in the ceiling are sound. Occasionally check the security of all parts

Cleaning

1. Always ensure that the light is switched off and cool before cleaning.
2. Only clean the glass shade using suitable glass cleaner. Do not use any abrasive cleaners as they might scratch the shade.

Due to the handmade nature of the production each piece is unique.
