Missing a call can be detrimental to any company with a Sales or Customer Service focus. You can be losing up to 10% of your companys sales opportunities through missed calls. The Blync light has been designed to physically alert co-workers that an incoming call is being received. Regardless if the user cannot see the incoming call on their desktop or have their volume turned down/headset plugged in, the Blync light will visually grab the attention of the worker prompting them to answer the call. As an extra contingency, the Blync light can be configured to display a missed call. This allows the worker to detect and return the call as soon as possible.
