## Section 1.7 - Wildland

### Task 1.7.3 - Reloading Pondosa Pack

**STANDARD:**

- 1) Properly reload Pondosa Pack.

**RESOURCES:**

- 1) Two 100' lengths 1.5" forestry hose
- 2) One 100" length 1" forestry hose
- 3) One 1.5" "T"
- 4) One 1" nozzle
- 5) One Pondosa Pack

**PROCEDURE:****1) Reload Pondosa Pack with clean hose.**

- a. "Donut roll" two 100" lengths of 1.5" forestry hose with couplings
  - i. Staggered about 12" with male fitting on inside of roll.
  - ii. Note: Donut roll hose with male coupling inside and 30" shorter than female coupling.
  - iii. Attach "T" fitting to **male** end of one of the lengths. Secure roll with rubber band
- b. Attach 1" nozzle to 100" length of 1" forestry hose and donut roll in same manner as 1.5" hose. Secure roll with rubber band
- c. Lay out pack with shoulder straps on floor and rear of pack facing up.
- d. Place 1" length on pack with nozzle toward top and secure with strap.
- e. Place the 1.5" length **without** the "T" on the pack next and secure with the strap.
- f. Place the last length **with** the "T" on the pack ("T" to the top) and secure with the strap.
- g. Readjust all straps and replace on engine.
