Task 1.7.6 Deployment of Fire Shelter Outside

STANDARD:

1. Properly deploy fire shelter

RESOURCES:

- 1. Full protective wildland clothing
- 2. Wildland hand tool
- 3. Fire shelter

PROCEDURE:

A. Deploy fire shelter on ground (Static)

- 1. Remove shelter from carrier and pull on opening tab.
- 2. Remove plastic cover.
- 3. Grasp handles and shake to open.
- 4. Stand (facing away from fire front) with shelter over back and entire body inside of straps.
- 5. Place feet in corners and spread so as to take up slack in shelter.
- 6. Drop to ground with feet toward fire front.
- 7. Be sure shelter is fully open and all edges down.
- 8. Hold head end of shelter with hands while the feet hold the other end.
- 9. If side or corner lifts during passage of fire front turn face away from opening.

B. Deploy fire shelter on ground (Dynamic)

- 1. Move rapidly towards a deployment zone or area of lighter fuels.
- 2. While on the move remove shelter from carrier and plastic cover.
- 3. Grasp handles and shake to open.
- 4. With shelter open get on the ground and roll into the shelter.
- 5. Adjust shelter and position as necessary to point feet towards the fire and ensure shelter is fully deployed.

Safety Considerations:

Maintain crew accountability at all times

Communicate shelter deployment to supervisor and adjoining resources ASAP Maintain communications within the crew at all times
