IAM suppliers are required to comply with IAM's Supplier Code of Conduct. This includes requirements that conflict minerals (tantalum, tungsten, tin and gold) have not originated in the DRC or any adjoining countries. IAM has implemented a comprehensive due diligence process to ensure that all obligations and reporting required under the Dodd-Frank Act will be assured.
