



New Yorker Scarf

Materials: 17 oz of Big Loop Yarn; size 50 (25 mm) knitting needles
Gauge: 3 stitches/4 inches

Finished garment size: 8" x 68"

One 40 oz skein of Big Loop Yarn will make 2 scarves

1. cast on 5 sts
2. knit all the way
3. cast off



Poseidon Scarf

Materials: 1 ball of Big Loop Mini yarn 10 oz, 30 yards; size U (25 mm) crochet hook

One 40 oz skein of Big Loop Yarn is enough to make 4 scarves.

1. make a slip knot
2. crochet chain using chain stitch until you run out of yarn
3. tie the ends together and weave them in

This project is for **absolute beginners**. It only takes **10 – 15 minutes** to complete. If you have never crocheted before you can simply watch our online tutorial below and make this scarf.

Eternity Cowl

Materials: 13 oz of Big Loop yarn, 32 yards; size 50 knitting needles
Gauge: 2 stitches/3 inches

Finished garment size: 6" (width) x 28' (length folded)

One 40 oz skein of Big Loop Yarn is enough to make 3 cowls.

1. cast on 4 sts
2. knit all the way leaving a tail of about 10 inches long (after cast off)
3. cast off
3. fold the rectangle in half and use remaining yarn to connect it to make a loop
