

CAMPFIRE SAFETY

Taking a camping adventure is the perfect way to enjoy a variety of hiking trails!



Don't let carelessness be the cause of a devastating wildfire!

If lighting a campfire, remember these important tips:

- Never build a campfire under trees or overhanging branches.
- Clear a 10-foot area of pine needles & grass from around the fire pit.
- Keep plenty of water nearby, and have a shovel handy.
- Keep all campfires small.
- Never leave a campfire unattended.
- Be sure your campfire is 'dead out' before you leave it. This means drench fire with water, spread out coals & cover with earth.
- Check for fire restrictions in your area.
- Never play with your campfire (e.g. Light wood torches, etc.)
