

Materials for the Table Runner

5% yard	Pheasant Cameo	8025-44
3⁄8 yard	Brown Paisley	8026-38
3⁄8 yard	Red Paisley	8026-88
½ yard	Blue Toile	8027-77
¾ yard	Blue Floral	8029-77
¼ yard	Caramel	8030-33
¾ yard	Dark Brown	8030-38
	(includes binding)	
3⁄8 yard	Cream	8030-44
1% yards	Pheasant Cameo	8025-44
	(for table runner backing)	

Cutting Instructions for the Table Runner

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of the fabric from selvage edge to selvage edge.

From the pheasant cameo, cut:

(2) 9" x 9" squares, fussy cut, with a pheasant cameo motif centered from corner to corner, in both directions, in each cut square.



From the brown paisley, cut:

- (1) 4¾" strip. Recut into (3) 4¾" x 4¾" squares.
- (2) 25%" strip. Recut into (24) 25%" x 25%" squares.

From red paisley, cut:

(1) 6%" strip. Recut into (6) 6%" x 6%" squares.

From the blue toile, cut:

- (1) 6%" strip. Recut into (4) 6%" x 6%" squares.
- (1) 3" strip. Recut into (8) 3" x 3" squares.

From the blue floral, cut:

(4) 4¾" strips for the outer border.

From the caramel, cut:

(1) 2" strip.

From the dark brown, cut:

- (1) 2" strip.
- (5) 21/4" strips for the binding.
- (4) 1½" strips for the inner border.


From the cream, cut:

(3) 2%" strips. Recut into (12) 25%" x 4¾" pieces and (12) 25%" x 25%" squares.


Sewing Instructions for the Table Runner

All seams are sewn using 1/4" seam allowance with pieces held right sides together and raw edges even.


1. Cut each of the assorted 3" and 6%" squares in half on a diagonal as shown to yield a total of (80) 3" and (20) 6%" triangles.




2. Referring to the diagram at the top of the next column, stitch 6%" blue toile triangles, cut in step 1, to each side of a 9" pheasant cameo square, matching the center point of the triangle's long side to the center point of each side of the square. This should yield (1) Diamond in a Square block measuring 12½" from raw edge to raw edge in both directions. Repeat to make a second identical block.




3. Draw diagonal lines on the wrong side of (2) 25%" brown paisley squares. Right sides together, layer a marked square on one end of a 25%" x 434" cream piece, noting orientation. Sew on the marked line. Cut 1/4' beyond the seam line and press the resulting brown triangle up. Repeat this procedure for the opposite end of the cream piece, as shown, to yield (1) star point unit. Repeat to make a total of (4) identical star point units.



4. Arrange (1) 4¾" brown paisley square, (4) 25%" cream squares, and the (4) brown paisley star point units made in step 3 into (3) rows with (3) units in each row, noting orientation of the star point units. Stitch the units into rows and sew the rows together to make (1) star unit.



5. Stitch a 6%" red paisley triangle cut in step 1 to each side of the star unit made in step 4, matching the center points of each triangle's long side with the center points of the star unit sides. This should yield (1) Diamond in a Square block measuring 12½" from raw edge to raw edge in both directions.


- 6. Repeat steps 3 and 4 to make a total of (3) identical blocks.
- 7. Referring to the Table Runner Assembly Diagram in the next column, stitch together the (5) Diamond in a Square blocks, end to end, alternating the paisley and pheasant blocks.
- 8. Trim the selvages from the 1½" dark brown strips. Sew the strips together, end to end, to make a long 1½" strip. From this long strip, cut (2) 60½" and (2) 14½" lengths (if your measurements are different, cut to fit your runner). Stitch the longer lengths to the left and right sides of the runner. Sew the shorter lengths to the top and bottom.
- 9. Trim the selvages from the 4¾" blue floral strips. Sew the strips together, end to end, to make a long 4¾" strip. From this long strip, cut (2) 62½" and (2) 14½" lengths (if your measurements are different, cut to fit your quilt top). Stitch the longer lengths to the left and right sides of the runner.
- 10. Sewing lengthwise, stitch a 2" caramel strip to a 2" dark brown strip. The strip set should measure 3½" high from raw edge to raw edge. From this strip set, cut (8) 2" wide segments.



11. Stitch (2) caramel/dark brown strip set segments together, noting orientation, to make (1) four-patch block center.




12. Stitch a 3" triangle cut in step 1 to each side of the fourpatch block center made in step 11, matching the center point of each triangle's long side to the center seam on each side of the four-patch, to yield one block measuring 4¾" from raw edge to raw edge in both directions.



- 13. Repeat steps 11 and 12 to make a total of (4) identical blocks.
- 14. Stitch a four-patch block to each end of 4¾" x 14½" blue floral border strip. Stitch these pieced borders to the top and bottom of the table runner.
- 15. Layer the completed table runner top with batting and backing and quilt as desired. Bind the finished table runner using the 2¼" dark brown strips.
