

Super-Sized Hat

Designed by Trish Mitberg

Materials:

2 skeins *Rowan Big Wool* (87yds/100g)
US size #17 – 16" circular and double pointed needles
Stitch marker
Darning needle
Pom pom maker (*optional*)

Gauge: 6.5-7 sts = 4" in garter st with yarn doubled

Size: Approx. 21" around.

Directions:

Holding two strands of yarn together, loosely cast on 36 sts. Place marker and join for working in the round, being careful not to twist your sts.

Round 1: Purl

Round 2: Knit

Repeat these two rounds until you have 10 garter ridges.

Purl one more round creating an 11th ridge.

Decrease for top of hat as follows, switching to double pointed needles when necessary.

Round 1: *K4, k2tog* repeat around.

Round 2: Purl.

Round 3: *K3, k2tog* repeat around.

Round 4: P2tog around.

Round 5: K2tog around. (6sts remain)

Cut yarn, leaving a 6" tail. Pull through remaining sts to close the top of hat.

Make a super-sized pom pom and securely attach to the top of the hat using the yarn tail.

Weave in all ends.
