

Clay Shooting: Basic Checklist

Shooting locations can have specific requirements for attire, gear and identification. Call ahead or look online to ensure you meet the location's requirements. Check weather to dress appropriately.

Identification & License

- ☐ Government Issued I. D.
- ☐ Gun Permit if required at location

Guns & Ammo

- ☐ Shot Gun
- ☐ Ammo
- ☐ Choke Tubes
- Gun Case
- ☐ Cartridge Bag, Shell Pouch or Shooting Vest with pockets to carry ammo on the course
- ☐ Range Bag or Back Pack to carry all other gear to the shooting location
- Gun Tools

- Clay Target Thrower
- Clay Targets
- ☐ Gun Rack

What to wear

- Shooting Shirt
- Shooting Vest
- Recoil Pads unless the shirt or vest already has recoil protection
- Hat or Cap are typically optional, though some places require them
- Shooting Gloves
- Protective Eyewear
- □ Protective Earmuffs or Earplugs
