

Upland Hunting: Basic Checklist

Check local law requirements regarding hunting licenses and use of blaze orange.

Also, some hunts require specific traditional attire. This list is for standard upland hunting.

Check weather to dress appropriately.

Proper Attire Required

Blaze Orange
Warm
Traditional Attire required for certain hunts

Identification & License

- ☐ Government issued I. D.
- Hunting License
- ☐ Federal and State Hunting Stamps
- ☐ Gun Permit if required by law

Guns & Ammo

- Shot Gun
- ☐ Ammo, Non-toxic if required at location
- Choke Tubes
- Gun Case
- ☐ Field Bag, Back Pack, Game Belt or Cartridge Bag
- Gun Tools

Clean & Carry Game

- Knife
- Knife Sharpener
- Game Carrier
- Resealable Plastic Bags
- Cooler

What to Wear

- Hunting Shirt
- Hunting Vest with blaze orange *
- Jacket or Upland Coat
- □ Hat or Cap with blaze orange *
- ☐ Gloves with insulation or without it, depending on weather
- Long Underwear or Layers with moisture wicking and insulation, depending on weather
- Brush Pants or Chaps
- □ Suspenders are optional
- □ Socks made of alpaca or wool— thickness of socks depends on weather
- Boots, Snake Boots and/or Gaiters
- Protective Eyewear
- Protective Earmuffs or Earplugs

What else to bring— Better be safe than sorry!
