

color changing tape flower bookmark

What you need - One print of this pattern on card stock, Chameleon Skinz™ orange to yellow color changing tape, Chameleon Skinz™ purple to pink color changing tape, Chameleon Skinz™ blue to white color changing tape, Chameleon Skinz™ green to yellow changing tape, white craft tape, 1/4" (or larger) colored rhinestone, 9.5 piece of 1/4" ribbon, wax paper, scissors, hole punch and a hot glue gun.



Instructions - Print pattern on card stock. Cut out pattern pieces about an 1/8" from pattern line. Turn bookmark piece over and adhere a piece of Chameleon Skinz™ orange to yellow color changing tape to card stock pattern piece. Turn over and trim to the pattern line. Adhere another piece of orange tape to the front of the bookmark, turn over and trim excess. Place about a 2" piece of white craft tape on a piece of wax paper, cover with a small piece Chameleon Skinz™ purple to pink color changing tape over the white tape. Place the pattern of the large flower over the tape and cut out. Place about a 1.5" piece of white craft tape on a piece of wax paper, cover with a small piece Chameleon Skinz™ blue to white color changing tape over the white tape. Place the pattern of the small flower over the tape and cut out. Place a 4.5" piece of white craft tape on a piece of wax paper, cover with a piece Chameleon Skinz™ green to yellow changing tape over the white tape. Place the patterns of the stem and leaves over the tape and cut out. Position the stem, leaves, large and small flowers as shown on the example above. Put a small dot of hot glue on the back of the rhinestone and adhere to the center of the flower. With a hole punch, punch a hole at the top of the bookmark, centered, about 1/4" from the top. Cut a piece of ribbon of your choice to about 9.5", cut ends at an angle. Fold in half, pull loop through the hole of the bookmark and pull the ends of the ribbon through the loop. Enjoy your new color changing bookmark!
