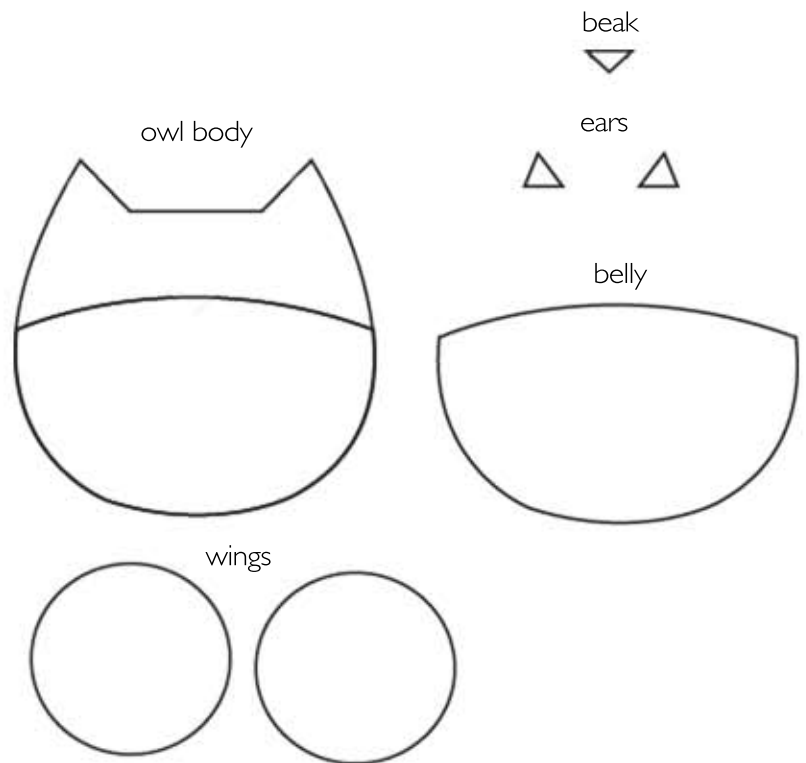


color changing tape

owl pin

What you need - Print of owl pin pattern printed on card stock, Chameleon Skinz™ orange to yellow color changing tape, Chameleon Skinz™ purple to pink color changing tape, Chameleon Skinz™ blue to white color changing tape, 5/16" sequins, parchment paper, 1/4" rhinestones, white craft tape, scissors (and/or craft knife), pin back, hot glue gun



Instructions - Cut out the pattern pieces leaving a little bit of white around each piece. Turn over the owl body pattern piece and adhere a piece of Chameleon Skinz™ orange to yellow color changing tape. Turn over and trim along pattern line. Turn over and cover with another piece of Chameleon Skinz™ orange to yellow color changing tape, turn over and trim excess tape off. Place a 2.5" piece of white craft tape on a piece of wax paper, cover with a piece of Chameleon Skinz™ blue to white color changing tape. Place owl belly pattern piece over and cut out. Place a 2.5" piece of white craft tape on a piece of wax paper, cover with a piece of Chameleon Skinz™ purple to pink color changing tape. Place owl wings pattern pieces over and cut out. Cut out beak and ears out of your choice of white or colored tape. To assemble, place belly onto owl body as shown above. Place wings onto body as shown above, turn over and trim excess tape off. With a small dab of hot glue, adhere the sequins and rhinestones as shown above to create eyes. Adhere ears and beak as shown above. Turn over and adhere pin back with hot glue.
