

PERFORMANCE & SPECS

The Arrow Series 10 Beam Chemical Pump provides a reliable and versatile means of injecting chemicals under any operating conditions. It was designed for the injection of de-emulsifiers, solvents, corrosion inhibitors, scale inhibitors, lubricants and other chemicals for operation on a beam pumped well. The Arrow Series 10-B Chemical Injectors are positive displacement type pumps powered by direct connection with rod, 1/4" pipe or cable to the walking beam or rod line. The cam mechanism is housed in a precision-bored, heavy cast iron case and runs submerged in oil for long life. The unit pumps on the upstroke of the walking beam then returns to its set position on the downstroke.



The Arrow Series 10-B Beam Operated Chemical Injector Pump is available in either single or double head configurations with steel (standard) or 316 stainless steel heads for corrosion protection. The Arrow Beam Pump is normally located at the base of the Sampson post on the pump jack and mechanically connected to the walking beam with the ASA-700 beam clamp assembly furnished with each pump.




VOLUMETRIC CONVERSION



INSTALLATION

When installing the Arrow Series 10 Beam Operated Chemical Injector, care must be taken to be sure the suction side of the injection head will be flooded with the chemical that is being injected. The beam pump must be located so the operating lever can move to a point at least 3" below the base of the case and have ample clearance above the pump (approximately 16") for full travel of the lever (fig.1.) Back the stroke adjustment off completely to allow the striker plate (ASA-4034-BA) movement. This reduces the compression of 232-96 (232-46 for two heads) plunger return spring.

INSTALLATION




- **1** Remove pump from carton and inspect for possible damage in transit from factory. If the pump has been damaged in transit, file claim with the carrier.
- **2** Bolt holes are provided for a permanent mounting (fig 2.)
- Connect the suction line to bottom of pump head. If a reservoir is furnished with the pump, the suction line is already connected.
- Connect the discharge line (5/16" copper tubing will suffice). An ASA-675 stainless steel line check is provided. This valve should be installed as close to the point of injection as possible. Note the arrow in the check valve indicated the direction of the flow. The top connection on the pump head is the outlet and has ½" female pipe thread connection.
- **5** Connect ASB-67 lever to the power source as follows:
 - a. Attach ASA-538 Knuckle Assembly to outer hole of ASB-67 lever.
 - b. Locate a point on the walking beam where there is 16¼" of travel. Attach the ASA-700 beam clamp at this exact spot and there will be 1" of plunger stroke. If less than 1" of stroke is needed, turn the stroke adjusting screw to the necessary setting.
 - c. A 3.8" OD rod, pipe or a cable (usually 10'or 12' is required for an oilfield walking beam pump). Attach an ASA-700 beam clamp to the walking beam. Insert rod, pipe or cable in the ASA-538 connecting knuckle on the ASB-67 lever arm. Tighten set screws to secure position of rod or pipe

- Manually operate ASB-67 lever arm until the pump discharges fluid without air bubbles in the chemical stream.
- Close ASA-1497 valve for normal operation.
- 4 Start primer mover.
- Make visual check of plunger drip; use ASA-315 gland wrench included in package to slowly tighten gland to prevent excess drippage. DO NOT OVER TIGHTEN plunger packing. A couple of drops of fluid per minute during break-in is beneficial. After one or two days operation, readjust packing to eliminate dripping.

OPERATION

Pump volume is adjusted simply by changing the plunger stroke length. With the outside stroke adjusting knob 205-46, turn to right to decrease pump volume and left to increase pump volume. For good pump operation, the pump head, the fluid discharge line, and all other fittings up to the line check should be thoroughly purged of all air bubbles. Check pump action by opening ASA-1497 priming valve.

HEAD REPLACEMENT & ADDITION


- 1 Pull the plunger from the yoke and head assembly.
- Place the ASA-1227-BA spring retainer on the ASA-4045 plunger connector.
- Insert the plunger into the hole in the plunger connector and line up the cross drilled hole in the plunger pin through the plunger connector and center hole of the plunger. See FIG 2.
- Place the 232-96 (232-46 for two heads) spring over the plunger and by compressing the spring, insert fluid end of plunger through the 1" hole in the end of the case and have the plunger connector far enough down the strike plate for the plunger to be horizontal with the case.
- Carefully insert the plunger in the yoke and injector head assembly and screw the yoke into the case. Special care should be taken with the 3/16" plunger as it is more susceptible to damage by bending the 3/16" end.
- **6** Tighten yoke with a wrench.








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


BEAM PUMP, TANK & BASE ASSEMBLY



LUBRICATION

The Arrow Series 10 Beam Operated Chemical Injector Pump must have the case filled with oil before it is put into service. Use an all-weather motor oil grade 10W30. The oil level should be held to just below the stroke adjusting screw.

INJECTOR HEAD

The positive displacement fluid end is virtually trouble free, easy to maintain, and has stainless steel trim standard. The built-in priming valve aids in priming, checking pump action and catching chemical samples. External packing gland and protective felt wiper protect plunger from sand, dirt, and other damaging elements. The box assembly is heavy cast iron for maximum rigidity and has a plastic lid and rigid steel lever arm. The injector head can be easily removed for cleaning and maintenance. An additional injector head can be installed if more volume is required or if there is a need to pump dissimilar fluids.

TROUBLESHOOTING

SYMPTOM		CORRECTIVE ACTION
Injector head not pumping chemicals.	1	Check level of chemical in container.
	2	Check the screen in the tank or barren gauge.
		To do this, remove the tubing connector at the suction end of the head, and fluid should flow from the tubing.
	3	Check bottom bushing first, then top. Clean debris or replace seats. Reinstall.
	4	Inspect the conditions of the o-ring seats. If worn, they need to be replaced.
Pump fails to push the plunger into the injector head.	1	Check the lever (p/n ASB-67) for damage and whether it is able to turn the camshaft (p/n ASA-4035-BA).
The lever is turning the shaft, but the cam is not moving.	1	Roll Pin (p/n 41A-3/16X11/2) has been sheared and needs to be replaced.
The spring (p/n 232-96) does not turn the plunger on each stroke.	1	Plunger packing nut is over tightened, or packing has swelled by aromatic chemicals or paraffin solvents and should be loosened with the packing gland wrench provided.







CHEMICAL PUMP AND CHEMICAL PUMP PARTS WARRANTY

I. TERMS OF EXPRESS LIMITED WARRANTY

Arrow Engine Company warrants that it will repair or replace, at its election and expense, a chemical pump or chemical pump part (hereinafter referred to as "Products") manufactured by Arrow Engine Company, which proves to have had a defect in material or workmanship. All warranty work must be preapproved by Arrow Engine Company.

II. TERM LIMITATIONS OF EXPRESS LIMITED WARRANTY

This coverage shall commence upon shipment of Product and shall expire 1 year after ship date.

III. ARROW ENGINE COMPANY'S RESPONSIBILITIES UNDER THE EXPRESS LIMITED WARRANTY

Arrow Engine Company shall be responsible for:

A. The repair or replacement, at Arrow Engine Company's election, of covered product and all reasonable labor required regarding a warranted failure during the express limited warranty and term. All such labor shall be provided by Arrow Engine Company's authorized contractor or distributor.

B. Reasonable and necessary travel (total mileage not to exceed 300 miles) and expenses incurred by Arrow Engine Company's authorized contractors or distributor. Additional mileage and/or travel by air, water or land will need preauthorization from Arrow Engine Company.

C. Replacement of lubricating oil, coolant, filter elements, or other normal maintenance items that are contaminated and/or damaged as a direct result of a warranted failure.

NOTWITHSTANDING THE FOREGOING, ARROW ENGINE COMPANY SHALL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR LABOR COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH WARRANTY CLAIMS.

IV. OWNER/ DISTRIBUTOR/ CONTRACTOR'S RESPONSIBILITIES UNDER THE EXPRESS LIMITED WARRANTY

Owner shall be responsible for:

- A. The operation and maintenance of the Product within the guidelines established by Arrow Engine Company.
- B. Making the Product available to Arrow Engine Company or authorized contractors or distributors for any warranty repair, during normal business hours.
- C. All additional costs incurred for premium or overtime labor, should owner request that repairs be made on a premium overtime schedule.
- D. All costs incurred as the result of removal or reinstallation of the Product as may be required to effect any warranted repair.
- E. All administrative costs and expenses resulting from a warranted failure.
- $F.\ Any\ costs\ of\ transportation,\ towing,\ repair\ facilities,\ or\ associated\ costs.$
- G. Loss of revenue and loss of/or damage to real and/or personal property.
- H. All warranty work must be pre-approved by Arrow Engine Company
- I. Warranted repairs not to exceed 50% of the product replacement cost without prior approval from Arrow Engine Company. Replacement cost equates to distributor net price from factory.

V. LIMITATION OF ARROW ENGINE COMPANY'S OBLIGATIONS

The obligations of Arrow Engine Company under this express limited warranty shall be waived and voided, and Arrow Engine Company shall not, thereafter, be responsible for:

- A. Any failure resulting from owner or operator abuse or neglect, including but not by way of limitation, any operation, installation, application, or maintenance practice not in accordance with guidelines or specifications established by Arrow Engine Company; or
- B. Any failure resulting from unauthorized modifications or repairs of the Products or;
- C. Any failure resulting from overload, overspeed, overheat, accident, improper storage; or
- D. Failure of owner, contractor or distributor to promptly provide notice of a claimed defect. All warranty claims must be authorized, documented and submitted within 30 days of the failure date while under the warranty period; or
- E. Failure of Products for which Arrow Engine Company did not receive properly completed start-up reports; or
- F. Repairs of a covered failure performed with non-genuine Arrow Engine Company parts; or
- G. Repairs of a covered failure performed by non-authorized contractors or distributors; or
- H. Failure to make Products available to Arrow Engine Company or its authorized representatives, or
- I. Failure to supply documents such as drawing and specifications relating to the specific application of the Products.


VI APPLICABILITY AND EXPIRATION

Any action arising hereunder or relating hereto, whether based on breach of contract, tort (including negligence and strict liability), or other theories must be commenced within one (1) year after the cause of action accrues or it shall be barred.

With respect to products not manufactured by Arrow Engine Company, Arrow makes no representations or warranties of whatsoever nature, directly or indirectly, expressed or implied including but not limited to any representations or warranties with respect to suitability, durability, fitness for a particular purpose or merchantability, except to the extent that Arrow can enforce warranties provided by the manufacturers of such parts.
