

Limeade Blast –Reliable and Compact External battery Support

Limeade is a new technology that helps in pushing the limits of handy battery technology. The current batteries available on the market have lower capacities and users would always need to remember charging them from time to time. The top model of Limeade Blast has enough juice for charging an iPhone 5 12 times until the next recharge.

Traditionally, external battery charges have been heavy and bulky to be effective. The Limeade Blast series has each one of its battery packed with lots of power within a compact design. Its weight can range between 11 and 13 oz., and you can place it in your purse, pocket or backpack without all the heavy weight.

The external batteries currently available on the market rely on 1 Amp inputs. On the other hand, Limeade external batteries have 2 Amp inputs, which is a first of its kind in the industry. It is possible to charge them in just 11 hours. The L180X battery with 18000mAh capacity is the most inventive product from Limeade, in addition to other products including L156X and L130X.

Applications of the Innovative External Batteries

Limeade Blast could be used for charging two devices at one time. This makes it the ideal external charging point to fulfill your family needs. It can also be taken along on outdoor activities and adventures such as camping, hiking, fishing, skiing and mountain biking. All you have to do is to put the Blast into a backpack and charge your devices outdoors in location where there is no availability of charging outlets.

Limeade Blast is also the perfect charge repository for commuters who want to keep their devices juiced up when moving on the train or bus. It would help in keeping your phone working so that you would never miss any critical calls. This external battery can also replace the combination of converters and adapters that you would otherwise take to your vacation or travel abroad. Your devices would keep working when you are on a plane.

The Limeade Blast can retain its charge for more than a year. This makes it a reliable source of power that can come of use when you need it the most. It can act as the recharging repository and backup to help keep your devices remain charged on a daily basis.

When it comes to input charging for the Blast, the duration depends on the charger output speed. While a 1Amp charger takes around 13 hours to charge, the 2Amp charger speed charges the L130X within just 8 hours. The Limeade Blast 18000mAh can charge different types of devices multiple times. Dividing 18,000 by the number of mAh of a device can give the number of times it can be charged with the Blast 18000mAh.

Apple iPhone 4 to iPhone 5 smartphones can be charged more than 12 times. If you have a Samsung Galaxy SIII, it can be charged minimum 8 times before you would need to recharge your external battery. The Blast 18000mAh can charge your Samsung Galaxy Note up to 7 times, Sony PSP more than 11 times, Google Nexus 4 around 8 times and the Apple iPod Nano more than 170 times.

Limeade Blast Availability

The Limeade Blast was launched on May 2, 2013 and it would be available on the market from June 2013 onwards. It is estimated to be shipped in June 2013.

The Kit

Every order contains 1 External Battery Pack and the 2.1 micro USB adapter cable, which can be directly plugged into the 30-pin Apple adapter. This adapter can be removed for connecting to non-Apple devices. The cable can be plugged into the external battery and connected with the right adapter. It has a 2.5-foot long cable that can be used for charging the external battery.

It is also possible to charge these external batteries from a 220-Volt power supply. This would require the use of a special adapter. The external batteries are compatible with most of the USB devices including tablets, mobile phones, e-readers, music players, cameras and game consoles. It is available in three models with different capacities and they weigh just between 11 and 13 oz.
