READ THOROUGHLY BEFORE ATTACHING BAGS TO RACKS

For best results take a test ride before putting your Expedition Dry Saddle Bags to use

Helpful hint: Before you begin stuff each bag with a sleeping bag or quilt to give it body

The mounting is the same for both left and right bags


FIG2 Left side

*Please note the various parts of the saddlebag. Since the left and right bags are identical only one is shown.

ATTACHING EXPEDITION DRY SADDLE BAGS TO VIRTUALLY ANY MOTORCYCLE SIDE RACK

1- Unclip the 1" center buckles on the upper and lower mounting patches and loosen the 1" side mounting straps. FIG4



2- Place bags over the seat and/or rear rack. Depending on the width of your motorcycle, you may need to adjust the height of each bag. Do this by adjusting the 2" seat strap webbing from the large center buckles. Adjust so that the bags are centered on each side rack. FIG5

ATTACHING THE SADDLBAG STRAP TO THE SIDE RACK

3- Thread the 3/4" slide from the inside of the side rack hoop around the tube to the outside. FIG6

4- Thread the 3/4" slide through the open loop on the chrome slide, as shown in FIG7

Correctly threaded Saddle Bag Straps will have the wolf logo visible.

5- Tighten the 1" mounting strap which will tighten the saddle bag strap and the 3/4" slide is captured, as shown in FIG8



6- Repeat steps 6-8 for all Saddle Bag Straps (4 per bag).

7- Pictured are correctly mounted top and bottom Saddle Bag Straps. FIG9

8- Re-clip the 1" center buckles on each front top and bottom patch. FIG10

9- Tighten the 1" side mounting straps to secure and compress the bag to the rack, pull away from the 1" center buckles in the direction of the Arrows. FIG11

10- Thread excess webbing through plastic loop and strap keeper, repeat this for all excess webbing. FIG12



Plastic loop and strap keeper (4 per bag).

11- Tighten the 2” wide seat straps by pulling the webbing away from the 2” buckles. FIG13



Always use the seat straps. The Expedition Dry Saddle Bags and racks are designed for these, as the seat straps distribute the weight of the bag. Failure to use the seat straps can result in damage to the bags, motorcycle and bodily harm. This will also void any and all warranties.

Loading the bags. You can load the bags either on or off the bike.

12- Loading and unloading the bags while on the racks: You will have to unclip the 1” center buckles on the upper and lower side mounting straps to release the compression of the bag, doing this will make the contents slip in and out much easier.

13- When closing the Expedition Dry Saddle Bags make sure you roll the bags down to “burp” and let as much air escape as possible. Re-roll the main bag with a minimum of 3 rolls to create a tight seal. Fasten the side straps. Pass the top compression strap through the upper D-ring above the top 1” center buckle and fasten to the top clip securely. This strap keeps the Expedition Dry Saddle Bags tight to the side racks and prevents the bag from sagging. FIG14

14- For maximum safety make sure ALL straps are snug and secure. Make adjustments as necessary.

To remove the bags:

15- Loosen the two 1” center buckles on the upper and lower side mounting straps, this will release the tension on the Universal Saddle Bag Strap secured to the rack. Reverse steps 3 through 8. Do the lower Straps first then the upper straps.

On the exhaust side, be careful not to touch the exhaust as you can be burned!

16- Use the top straps as handles and remove the bags away from the side racks.FIG15



Note: All of the mounting straps on the Wolfman Expedition Dry Saddle Bags are removable and replaceable. Extra mounting kits can be purchased from us.
MAXIMUM WEIGHT LIMIT: 13lbs (5.9 kg) per bag.
