

Thank you for purchasing the Timberwolf tank bag.

Instructions for mounting:

1. Make sure your tank and the bottom of the bag are clean and free of dirt.
2. Remove the seat or raise it so it is out of the way.
3. Take the rear strap of webbing (the rear is the handle side of the bag with the single buckle) and feed it around the frame close to the gas tank. **Be careful not to pinch wires and hoses!!!** Even the ends of webbing and feed them through the male buckle.
4. Replace seat, making sure the buckle and web are sticking out.
5. Unfasten the two front straps from the two rear buckles and webbing keeper. Loop each around the frame at some point then back through the small plastic loop. Make sure not to pinch any hoses or wires. Even the ends out and feed them through the webbing keeper and through the buckles.
6. Place the bag on the tank and fasten all the buckles. Center the bag by tightening the rear strap and then the front straps. Place the front straps back through the webbing keeper (this will keep the ends from flapping around).
7. Cut off any extra webbing leaving enough tail to tighten the straps (about 6" on the front and about 4" in rear).
8. **Helpful hint:** When filling up with gas, unbuckle one of the front buckles and slide the bag over to access the gas cap. When done, re-clip the buckle.
