



# Express Tank Bag

## 4-point Universal Strap Mounting

### Installation:

1. Make sure your tank and the bottom of the bag are free of dirt, etc.  
NOTE: Since this bag is designed for many motorcycles it is only a guide.
  2. **Figure 1:** A correctly mounted Express Tank Bag.
  3. **Figure 2:** Front and Rear mounting harness assembly. Both front and rear are identical.
  4. Unthread the straps from each of the male buckles and each side of the keeper.
  5. **Figure 3:** Front of bike.
  6. Thread the cut end of a mounting strap around a frame member, radiator mount or fairing mount, etc.
  7. Thread cut end of strap through the rectangular buckle sewn at the opposite end of the strap and pull tight to confirm it is secure.
  8. Do this for other side. Then thread both raw ends of the webbing through the slots of the keeper and through each male buckle.
  9. **Figure 4:** Rear of bike. It may be necessary to remove the seat.
  10. The mounting is the same as in Steps 6,7 and 8 but mounting points may be a frame member, tank mount, shock mounts, etc.
  11. Take care to not pinch any wire or hoses.
  12. Tighten straps snug in front and rear.
  13. To gas up, unclip front two straps and tilt the tank bag bag onto the seat. Fuel. Re-clip and tighten. Enjoy!

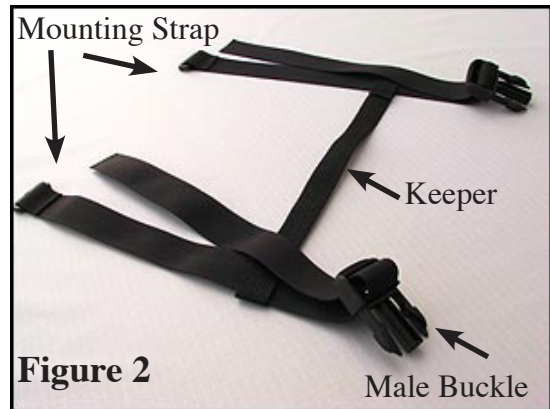

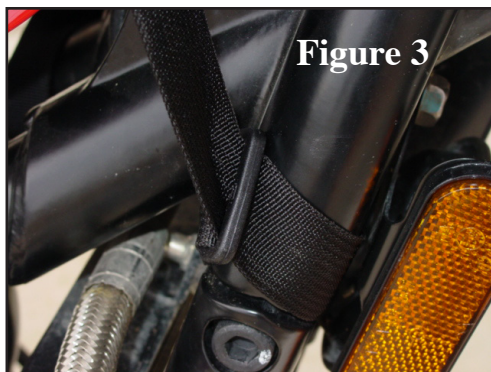
