FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. What is CIY ENGAGE?

Students will arrive at CIY ENGAGE and immediately be immersed into the experience as they work alongside others from their youth group. From painting houses to landscaping to cleaning up parks, students will learn how to be the hands and feet of Jesus through acts of service.

2. What will my student be doing in Tulsa, OK?

CIY ENGAGE groups will work with churches and community schools to build upon current outreach to specific neighborhoods. These environments allow your student to connect with missional leaders, train to engage people, do kingdom work and become kingdom workers now and at home.

3. What do sleeping arrangements look like?

Rooms accommodate 4 people.

4. What kind of supervision will there be?

We take adult leaders who have been screened and completed background checks to CIY ENGAGE. Each leader is responsible for no more than 5 students.

5. How do you keep track of every student?

Students are assigned to a leader who is responsible for them. That leader will always be with them as they travel to their service projects, attend worship services, etc.

6. What does the registration cost cover?

The registration cost includes meals at the conference, activities, conference fees, housing, and transportation. Students will need to bring money for meals while traveling to/ from Tulsa. Conference merchandise and snacks are extra.

7. What type of transportation do you use?

We use 15-passenger vans driven by our adults.

8. When is departure?

CIY ENGAGE departure will be June 23. We will meet at the Sportcenter at 8:30 am. Our vans will depart promptly at 9:00 am.

9. When will students return?

Students will arrive at the Sportcenter on Friday, June 27, around 5:00 pm.

10. How do you determine rooming assignments?

Our goal is for every student to be in a room with at least one friend. If they have a preference on who they room with, make sure to fill that out on the online church form.

11. Does your student need to eat breakfast before coming on Monday morning?

Yes. Please be sure your student eats breakfast before arriving.
