SAN FRANCISCO, CA – June 23, 2014 – Six weeks after launching a direct-to-consumer ecommerce site that invites amputees to design stunning 3D printed custom fairings and other ornamentalations for their prosthetic legs, UNYQ has closed its seed-round of funding in the amount of \$1,050,000 US dollars. Fairings are attractive and highly customizable protective covers that restore symmetry to a missing limb by mirroring the shape of the amputee’s sound leg.

“The seed funding will enable us to invest in state-of-the-art 3D printers and related technologies. We will also expand our product lines to include both lower and upper extremity fairings and accessories,” said Eythor Bender, co-founder and CEO of UNYQ.
