# diy Tassle Garland

## inoredients

TOOLS YOU'LL NEED
tissue paper (pick colors to match your party!) mylar or metallic tissue (hint: use hot glue!)
rope
cutting mat
rotary cutter
straight edge
bone folder - or - butter knife
quick-dry glue - or - hot glue
scissors
step $\sim$ by $\sim$ step

STEP \#I
Secure the ends of the rope somewhere in your home. (This will be in handy in a few minutes!)

STEP \#2
Grab a stack (approx. 8 sheets) of one color of tissue \& fold it in half. Lay the tissue on your cutting mat with the folded side towards the top (furthest away from you).

STEP \#3
Use the measurements on your cutting mat to line up the tissue. With a rotary cutter \& a straight edge, cut 5 strips that are $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ each.

## STEP \#4

Thread the butter knife through the top of each group of strips to pick them up. Pile all of them on top of each other to make one stack.

STEP \#5
Take the stack off of the butter knife \& twist it together starting from the center \& moving out towards both edges.

STEP \#6
Once you have twisted about 4 ", create a loop by placing the center of the twisted tissue around the rope \& twisting the two sides around each other. Essentially, you are making the tissue look like "rope".

STEP \#?
After approximately 4 twists, place a dot of glue to secure one side to the other.
sTEP \#8
After the glue dries, fluff the tissue by gently pulling it up, out \& away from the hanging strands of tissue.
step \#9
Use scissors to trim the uneven bottom.
step \#io
Repeat steps 1 through 9 for each tassle \& create a pattern alternating colors. idea! Have a party before your party! Invite friends over to help assemble this garland.

# diy Circle Garland 

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TOOLS YOU'LL NEED
GET CREATIVE WITH
circle stickers
colors \& sizes of circle stickers
linen string
step~by $\sim$ step . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . .
STEP \#I
Measure out the length of string you need.

STEP \#2
Select 2 circle stickers of the same size. They can either be the same color or complementary.
ster \#3
Stick them to one another sandwiching the string inbetween.

STEP \#4
Repeat steps 2 to 3 placing circles at regular intervals. Create a pattern or just make it random... either way this garland is simple \& cute too!
