



# diy Place Card: Chalkboard Painted Wine Glass

## ingredients . . . . .

### TOOLS YOU'LL NEED

wine glasses (one per guest attending your party)  
painters tape  
chalkboard paint  
wax paper  
chalk

### GET CREATIVE WITH

chalkboard paint colors\*  
*\*Home Depot can mix different colors for you!*

## step-by-step . . . . .

### STEP #1

Place a strip of painter's tape around the stem of the wine glass. This will be removed later to create a clean edge after the paint is dry.

### STEP #2

Open the paint can, give it a quick stir & spread wax paper out on your work surface.

### STEP #3

Dip the first wine glass into the paint stopping at the area marked with tape.

### STEP #4

Slowly pull the wine glass out of the paint. Let as much as possible drip off of the bottom before placing it on the wax paper.

### STEP #5

Repeat steps #1-4 with each wine glass.

### STEP #6

Gently move each wine glass every 20 minutes until dry. If necessary, rest the glass on its side overnight to allow the bottom to dry.

### STEP #7

When completely dry, carefully remove the tape from the stem. It may be necessary to clean up the edge with an xacto knife.

### STEP #8

Write guests' names on the base of the wine glass & place on the table at their place setting, Cent' anni!



# diy Place Card: Fruit with Paper Leaf

## ingredients . . . . .

### TOOLS YOU'LL NEED

peaches (one per guest attending your party)  
green paper printed with guests' names  
pencil  
xacto knife – *or* – scissors  
straight pins

### GET CREATIVE WITH

different fruits

## step-by-step . . . . .

### STEP #1

Print the names of your guests on green paper.  
Be sure to leave ample space around each name  
in order to account for the size of the leaf.

### STEP #2

With a pencil, lightly sketch a leaf shape  
around each name.

### STEP #3

Using either an xacto knife or scissors, cut out  
each leaf.

### STEP #4

Stick a straight pin through the paper at the  
base of the leaf & place the leaf on the peach.

### STEP #5

Distribute peaches to each guest's place setting.  
Buon appetito!



# *diy* Place Card: Glassware Embellishment

## ingredients . . . . .

### TOOLS YOU'LL NEED

cookie cutter to match your theme/decor  
cover weight paper printed with guests' names  
pencil  
xacto – *or* – scissors

### GET CREATIVE WITH

cookie cutter shapes  
paper colors  
decorations (washi tape, glitter, etc.)

## step-by-step . . . . .

### STEP #1

Print the names of your guests on paper. Be sure to leave ample space around each name in order to account for the cookie cutter shape.

### STEP #2

Center the cookie cutter on top of a name & lightly trace the shape with a pencil. Repeat with each name.

### STEP #3

Using either an xacto knife or scissors, cut out each shape.

### STEP #4

Make two small parallel cuts (approximately 1/16" apart) at the bottom of each shape & fold back the little strip of excess paper.

### STEP #5

Place shape on the rim of a glass at each guest's place setting. Cheers!
