



diy String Wrapped Vases

ingredients

TOOLS YOU'LL NEED

double sided tape (& maybe quick dry glue too!)
glass vase
string or yarn
scissors

GET CREATIVE WITH

rope (neon or jute is fun!)
ribbon (not too wide!)
vessels (recycled bottles, jars or containers)
make a pattern with colors & textures

step-by-step

STEP #1

Cover the bottom 1" (approximately) of the vase with double sided tape.

STEP #2

Pull some length of string from the spool & secure the end to the base of the vase.

STEP #3

Wrap the string around the base & then continue spiraling up the vase.
Tip: Make sure to pull the string taught & to keep each layer as close as possible to the previous one.

STEP #4

When necessary, pause wrapping the vase & apply more double sided tape to the surface.

STEP #5

When you reach the top or if you would like to change strings, simply cut the string & finish wrapping to desired end point.
Note: A small dot of quick dry glue may be required to adhere the end of the string firmly to the vase.

STEP #6

Fill with flowers, place on a table & admire your work.
