ingredients.

TOOLS YOU'LL NEED


white foam display board, tri-fold* xacto knife pencil ruler colored duct tape* red foam board* quick dry glue -or- hot glue gold paper ribbon binder clips (color coordinate with duct tape!) fabric for your backdrop *Available at office supply stores (Staples, Office Max, etc.)

GET CREATIVE WITH

use fabric markers to draw scenery on a white fabric backdrop create patterns on the outside of the puppet theater with different colors of duct tape use leftover wallpaper to cover the outside of the puppet theater

step-by-step . STEP #1

Using a pencil on the inside of the tri-fold display board, draw a rectangle according to the dimensions below.



STEP #2


Use an xacto knife with a fresh blade and straight edge to cut out the rectangle.

STEP #3

On the outside of the tri-fold display board, measure the center of the middle panel & make a light pencil mark.

STEP #4

On top of the mark you just made, run the first strip of colored duct tape from the top to the bottom of the display board (omitting the rectangular cut-out). Continue your pattern to the left & right edges.




diy Puppet Theater


step-by-step continued.. STEP #5

On the reverse side of red foam board, sketch a curtain. I like to use the corners of the foam board so I have nice neat edges & less cutting!




STEP #6

Using an xacto blade, cut out the curtain.




STEP #7

Flip over the first curtain & use it to trace the second curtain.




STEP #7 Cut out the second curtain.




STEP #8

Decorate the curtains with paper ribbon & then, using quick dry or hot glue, adhere the curtains to the front of the decorated tri-fold display board.



STEP #9

Use binder clips to clamp the fabric to the back of the tri-fold display board.



STEP #10

Gather an audience, it's time for your first puppet show!
