



# diy Paper Hats

## ingredients . . . . .

### TOOLS YOU'LL NEED

- newspaper
- construction paper (various colors)
- scissors
- quick-dry glue

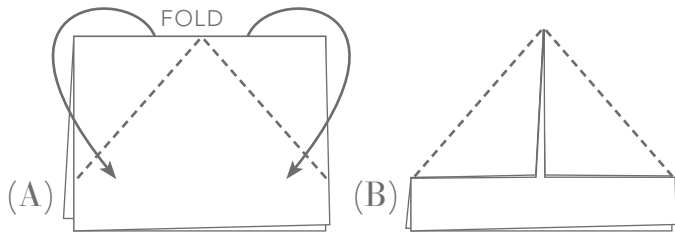
### GET CREATIVE WITH

- newspapers like The Financial Times (It's pink!)
- decorative papers
- markers (Mr. Sketch markers smell yummy!)
- glitter

## step-by-step . . . . .

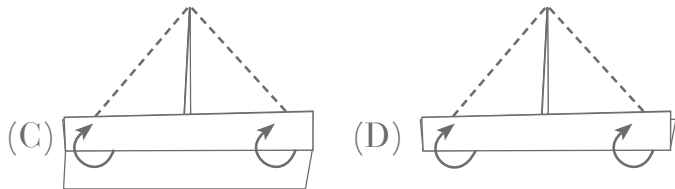
### STEP #1

Take a single sheet of newspaper folded on its natural creases & then fold the corners towards the middle (A) to create a triangle (B).



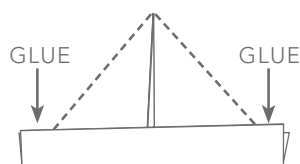
### STEP #2

Fold the bottom flap up (C) & then flip the hat over & fold the other side's bottom flap up (D). NOTE: 2 FOLDS MAY BE REQUIRED HERE.



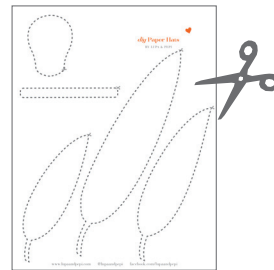
### STEP #3

Put a little dab of glue to hold the front flap to the back flap.



### STEP #4

The kids can decorate the hats with markers or glitter while you cut out the feather &/or skull & crossbones templates (page 2 of this PDF).



### STEP #5

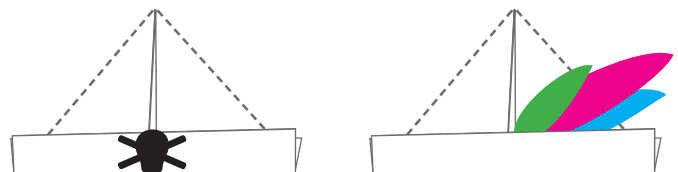
Trace the templates onto decorative paper & cut out the shapes. NOTE: TEMPLATES CAN BE PRINTED DIRECTLY ON DECORATIVE PAPER TO OMIT THIS STEP.

### STEP #6

Fringe the feathers with fringing scissors (plain scissors work just fine, it will just take a few more snips!) & finish with glitter if you like!

### STEP #7

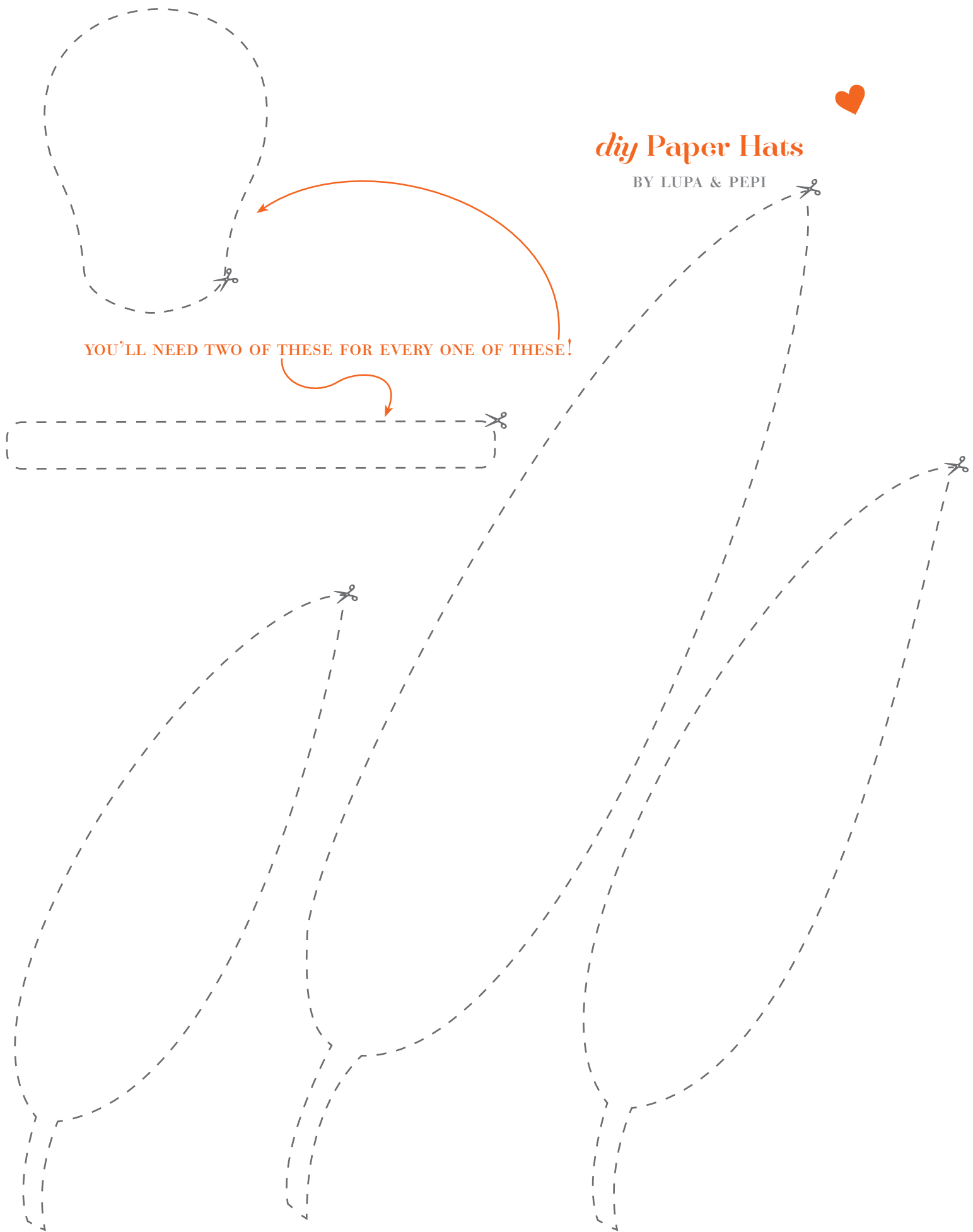
Glue the decorations onto the hats.
