# *diy* Photo Booth

### ingredients...

#### TOOLS YOU'LL NEED

dry erase poster board (joann.com) dry erase markers foamcore paint stirrers – *or* – wooden dowels quick-dry glue permanent marker (black Sharpie, king size) hot glue gun & glue wooden skewers construction paper xacto knife cutting mat scissors

#### GET CREATIVE WITH

decorative papers props back drops

## step-by-step .....

### speech bubbles step #1

Smear the back of dry erase poster board with quick-dry glue and adhere it to foamcore.

#### STEP #2

On the foamcore side, draw the speech bubble shape. Here's some inspiration:



#### STEP #3

Using an xacto knife with a fresh blade, cut out the speech bubble.\*

#### STEP #4

Using a Sharpie, draw a line\* on the dry erase side around the perimeter of the speech bubble.


### STEP #5


Use hot glue to adhere a paint stirrer/wooden dowel centered on the back of the speech bubble.

\*Don't worry about having a steady hand. Be a little messy to make it look more like a "comic strip"!

#### paper props step #1

Cut out the props (pages 2 & 3 of this PDF).





#### STEP #2

Trace them onto the colored construction and/or decorative paper & cut out the shapes. NOTE: TEMPLATES CAN BE PRINTED DIRECTLY ON DECORATIVE PAPER TO OMIT THIS STEP.

### STEP #3

Hot glue a wooden skewer to a strategic place on the left or right of the back of the prop & you are ready for some fun photos!
