



But Sahr wasn't always so happy. Last year, Sahr's father died, and his mother abandoned him. No extended family members were able to care for him. He was malnourished, barely existing in abject poverty, before being brought to All As One.

Sahr is now one of the "lucky ones." He has enough food to eat, a roof over his head, loving care, and a warm, dry place to sleep – all thanks to your help! Far too many children in Sierra Leone have none of these things. **New statistics estimate that Sierra Leone has 50,000 street children eking out a living each day.** These children have no regular meals, no roof over their head, no loving care, and no warm, dry place to sleep.

For these street children, life is going to get worse very soon. The rainy season in Sierra Leone starts in May and goes through September. Monsoon-like rains will deluge the country. Weeks will go by without a break in the rain. I shudder to think of what is going to happen to those thousands of children on the streets. The words that keep running through my mind are: All As One can, and MUST, do more -- and we need your help to do it! Please give generously today, so that we can give more children a loving home and get them off the streets.
